Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities including but not limited to:

Responsibilities:

- Leadership of young adults ministry by:
 - Developing a team of life group leaders, aka pastors, by:
 - Recruiting life group leaders
 - Equipping and providing support and development to life group leaders
 - Meeting 1-on-1 with leaders 2-3 times/year, tracking progress
 - Checking in with life group leaders a few times/month
 - Being available to minister to and serve each leader
 - Providing leaders with opportunities for personal development
 - Praying for life group leaders regularly
 - Planning annual leader training event
 - Planning/programming weekly events, which includes:
 - Overseeing various volunteer teams and schedules including music, production, host (greeters, coffee, check-in, info), meals, teaching, etc.
 - Teaching on a regular basis
 - Providing weekly curriculum (discussion guide) for life group environments
 - Setup and teardown after each event
 - Working with creative staff on teaching series' - graphics, videos, social media, etc.
 - Planning and leading an annual weekend retreat
 - Overseeing social media account
 - Meeting weekly with the student ministries pastor
 - Working with the executive pastor to establish and oversee a budget for the ministry
 - Keeping church database up to date
- Serve other Oasis ministries
 - Preaching on Sunday morning 1-2 times/year
 - Sunday morning announcements once/month
 - Teaching for adult life group videos a few times/year
 - Serving at Church-wide events, such as Volunteer Appreciation Night, Church picnic, etc.
